Building an "Airtight" Compliance Framework

- **Defensible Fairness:** With new 2026 labor regulations, "blanket bans" are a legal liability. An airtight policy must include Individualized Assessments, contextualizing findings to ensure compliance with the Fair Credit Reporting Act (FCRA) and Fair Chance laws.
